- Started at Columbia University Music Centre in 2000 by Douglas Repetto and soon spread around the world: there are currently 84 around the world with another 24 in the pipeline: currently 4 in the UK (London, Bristol, Manchester & Scotland) and 1 in Second Life.
- Format based around regular meetings to nurture a local electronic arts community, the free exchange of ideas and to encourage emerging, and established, artists to present new works for informal peer review.
- Largely non-commercial, free sharing space

dorkbot format ideas

- A line up of invitees – say 4 in a session.
- A show'n'tell (free-format) session.
- A workshop / hack lab session: focus on an exercise to build/hack something and share soldering irons
- Masterclasses: such as Arduino, robotics, etc.
- Other special events: musical extravaganza, single topic dork, day trips, outdoor events...
- UK summer dork camp (called Burning Dork and held in Dorking in 2008, this year in Dorset)
